

**King County Regional Homelessness Authority**  
**Advisory Board – Background Information**  
**October 7, 2020**

Interlocal Agreement Article IX, Section 4.

“The Implementation Board shall recognize a Continuum of Care Board created pursuant to 24 CFR Part 578 or its successor regulation to act as its Advisory Committee and serve the Implementation Board by providing a broad array of perspectives, if such Continuum of Care Board takes action to serve as the Implementation Board’s Advisory Committee. Members of the Advisory Committee shall be appointed by the Implementation Board. In the event that an existing Continuum of Care Board takes action to serve as the Authority’s Advisory Committee, the Implementation Board may confirm any or all of the members of the Continuum of Care Board as members of the Advisory Committee, or may appoint new members to the Advisory Committee as set forth in the Bylaws or policies approved by the Implementation Board. The Advisory Committee shall be comprised of individuals with experience related to preventing and ending homelessness, including but not limited to: persons currently experiencing homelessness, populations disproportionately impacted by homelessness, Homelessness Service Providers, business, healthcare, labor and/or workforce, homeless housing and services, behavioral health services, criminal justice system, child welfare and data evaluation.” (ILA pages 27-28)
