Summary of RFP Goals

Guided by RHA's <u>Theory of Change</u>, the Non-Congregate Alternatives to Shelter RFP is intended to extend Seattle's continuum of comprehensive, person-centered shelter solutions. The RHA aims to invest in additional non-congregate shelter options that will quickly add safe temporary shelter units to the existing non-congregate shelter currently operating in Seattle. These new non-congregate shelter dwellings will offer a place where people experiencing unsheltered homelessness can stay safe from communicable diseases while having access to behavioral health resources and supportive services to assist with the successful transition to permanent housing. Furthermore, the funding aids in achieving the racial equity goal of increasing the number of BIPOC individuals and couples who obtain permanent housing.
