Emergency Housing Voucher Housing Search and Tenancy Support Services RFP - Info Session Q&A

Question	Answer
Can the funds be used for people that were recently housed, or only on people/households that are still searching for housing?	The funding is intended to support all functions of housing navigation and tenancy support for households referred and served through the EHV program, including those in referral, voucher application and issuance, housing navigation, move-in and ongoing tenancy under the EHV program.
Can agencies reassign EHV's if the first client never used it or has disappeared?	Not at this time, as we're approaching the end of all EHV's available through the community.
Are agencies able to bill for past EHV work, or is the funding only for work performed after the agency is awarded?	The KCRHA acknowledges that EHV Agreement holding organizations have incurred operating expenses to support their agreed participation in the program, however the funding is intended to support housing navigation and tenancy support services from the contract effective date forward.
Are agencies limited to serving households who were connected with EHV's <i>by their agency</i> or are they able to apply for increased funding in the hopes of serving households with EHV's through another agency who may not have been funded?	The funding is intended to support the durable tenancy for EHV referral households that proposer organizations committed to support in their EHV Agreement. This funding is not intended to support prime contractor and subcontractor arrangements between EHV Agreement holding organizations. If a proposer has made an agreement or agreements with other organizations that do not intend to propose for the RFP in order to support EHV households those organizations referred for the program, please document those arrangements in the proposal.
