February 21 - March 9, 2023

Housing is the solution to homelessness.

Extra shelter space during extreme weather helps meet the immediate need for warmth but does not solve the root cause.

Activation Extension: Severe Weather Response Protocols have been extended tuntil Thursday, March 9. Please note that the Exhibition Hall shelter will close on March 1, and City Hall will open on March 1 and be available through March 9.
