2023 Safe Lot Request for Proposals(RFP)

Overview

The King County Regional Homelessness Authority is pleased to announce the availability of funds to support the creation and operation of one or more Safe Lot Programs. The programs will provide safe and secure parking spaces for individuals and families experiencing homelessness who are living in their vehicles. Guided by RHA's <u>Theory of Change</u>, the 2023 Safe Lot RFP is intended to extend Seattle's continuum of comprehensive, person-centered solutions for people experiencing homelessness who reside in their cars, RVs and other large vehicles. The RHA expects to award funds for projects that will:

- Ensure people living in cars, recreational and other large vehicles have safe accessible places to park and overnight their vehicles.
- Provide safe alternatives to street-based vehicular encampments for people that connect vehicle dwellers to effective exits to permanent housing.
- Promote system transformation to transition individuals out of vehicles and into permanent housing.

Additionally, the RFP applicants may apply for one or more RFP categories relevant to their organization's area of expertise. RFP application categories will include:

- Site Development
- Program Operations
- Behavioral Health Services
- Housing Search Services
