## **Summary of RFP Goals**

Guided by KCRHA's Theory of Change, the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) Behavioral Health Supportive Services Only - Peer Life Coach Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is intended to extend the Seattle-King County continuum of comprehensive, person-centered housing solutions. The KCRHA expects to award funds for organizations that will:

Start a Peer Life Coach program that works proactively with youth and young adults ages 18-24 to reduce
entries into homelessness, increase housing stability, and increase behavioral health service connections for
young adults experiencing or at imminent risk of homelessness.
