Summary of RFP Goals

Guided by RHA's <u>Theory of Change</u>, the 2023 North King County Severe Weather Response RFP is intended to extend the Seattle-King County continuum of comprehensive, person-centered housing solutions. The KCRHA expects to award funds for organizations that will:

- Offer a safe, dignified temporary emergency shelter where unhoused adults who seek respite
- from severe cold weather elements:
- Provide adequate staffing, supplies, immediate response to emergency conditions, in a dignified environment which fosters health and safety during critical weather incidents;
- Provide services grounded in a Housing First, Trauma-Informed, holistic support;
- The severe weather response will serve adults 18+ of all genders; and
- Advance equity for Black, Indigenous, and other people of color as well as individuals who identify as LGBTQ+ and individuals with disabilities.
