Context

As outlined in the King County Continuum of Care (CoC) Charter, the Coordinated Entry Committee (CEC) will “oversee policies and procedures related to Coordinated Entry” in King County. The CEC will be responsible for identifying and approving policies and procedures that guide the coordinated entry system (CES) in King County. King County Regional Homeless Authority staff will be responsible for implementation of those policies and procedures.
