Background

- Commenced in 2022 with Partnership for Zero initiative
- Operations to date
 - Mobility transfers for PFZ rapid re-housing
 - Individuals from downtown area – Third Avenue Project
 - Navigation Center closure
- June 2025 CEC voted to pilot use for shelter closures
 - Mary's Place Bellevue Family Shelter closure



Summary

- Mary's Place Bellevue Family Shelter closure lessons learned include
 - Confusion for MP staff in changing from standard 10:30 am – 12:30 pm case conferencing window to early morning window
 - KCRHA can add priority within appropriate population space
 - Doubled work for KCRHA staff to post and tiebreak resources twice



Recommendation

- Maintain prioritization for programs facing imminent closure
- Add priority within appropriate population space
- In the future, CEC should discuss continued operation of the early morning single adult case conferencing space
