New HMIS Agency Approval Policy

- KCRHA has created a process for new agencies to join HMIS who do not have a KCRHA contract.
- This helps more groups work together to serve people experiencing homelessness.
- Agencies must show they have a real need for HMIS, can handle client data safely, and follow our equity framework.
- All requests and appeals are reviewed by the System Performance Committee.
