## What is the NOFO?

- Notice of Funding Opportunity NOFO
- US Department of Housing and Urban Development HUD
- Continuum of Care CoC
- Lead Agency KCRHA

  - Include previous NOFO documents



## **Process Cadence**

- HUD Release NOFO
  - Timeline varies year-to-year
- KCRHA creates application(s) and open Request for Proposals (RFP)
- Providers apply
  - Renew
    - Annually, may potentially become biannual
  - Bonus Dollars
    - New money
- KCRHA facilitates Rate & Rank Process
- Submit Application to HUD with top applicants on behalf of CoC
- Wait for results



#### Candence Cont.

- KCRHA Post Results
  - KCRHA receives letter from HUD
    - KCRHA will send letters to agencies notifying of results
  - Local HUD Field Office Contracts
    - Usually in order of applications that start soonest
    - Contracts can take up to several months to begin
- Master Service Agreement with KCRHA
- Project Service Agreement
  - Subrecipient of funds



## **How to Prepare**

- Review past NOFO RFPS

- Compile minimum eligibility documents

- Best Practices
  - Be as detailed as possible, do not assume raters can 'fill in the gaps'
  - Use examples when possible



## How to Apply

- KCRHA post NOFA
- KCRHA post RFP
- Organizations must determine eligibility
  - Review entire RFP for full scope of work and requirements
  - Review application instructions
- KCRHA host Info Session
- Organizations apply outside Salesforce 2025
  - Follow RFP application instructions



#### Note

- NOFO is often a quick process
  - Please communicate back soon as possible if reached out to by KCRHA
- KCRHA cannot tell you what to apply for or if you are eligible
  - These must be determined by your agency
