Overview

Transition Grant – Permanent Supportive Housing/Rapid Rehousing/Joint Component to Transitional Housing

This opportunity is open only to currently funded CoC Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH), Rapid Rehousing (RRH), or Joint Component projects that wish to convert their current program type to Transitional Housing (TH). Applicants may not request more than their FY24 CoC award amount.

Guided by KCRHA's Theory of Change, this RFP seeks to strengthen the Seattle-King County continuum of comprehensive, person-centered housing solutions. Funding will be awarded to projects that:

- Transitional Housing (TH) & Intensive Services: Offer structured transitional housing combined with trauma-informed supportive services, clear plans for exits to permanent housing, and pathways for increased household income.
- System-Aligned, High-Impact Projects: Clearly respond to community needs, demonstrate strong performance outcomes, and leverage mainstream funding to maximize impact.
