 - Front door entrance will be locked, but staff can let you in
- Capacity: 30
- Single adults
- Service animals only
- Services include: snacks on site, housing navigation, help accessing mental health or substance use care, access to free hygiene items, access to transit passes/tickets

Salvation Army - SODO Bay A

- 1039 6th Ave S
 - Entrance at the North Gate, security will assist with entry
 - o (206) 660-9873
- Capacity: 35
- Adults (18+)
- Services include: peer support, help accessing medical care, help accessing mental health or substance use care, access to free hygiene items

Urban League - Christ Spirit Church

- 6115 Beacon Ave S
 - Call (206) 837-2746 for shelter availability, first come first served
- Doors open at 8:00 pm and close at 7:30 am the next day
- Capacity: 20
- Adults only (no families or pets)
