- ~~81%~~ 96% of all 2026 contracts are completed.
- Comprehensive monitoring kicks off this month
- CoC Program Monitoring:
 - DESC Greenlake
 - DV/SA Rapid Rehousing Program (YWCA)
 - Home at Last (YMCA)
 - Hickman House Joint Component RRH/TH (Salvation Army)
 - Kerner Scott House (DESC)
 - Multicultural IDD Integrated Support Team (MIDST) PSH (Open Doors)
 - Regional RRH for DV Consolidated (Lifewire, YWCA, New Beginnings)



FY24-FY25 NOFO Updates

- On **January 9, 2026**, HUD reopened the FY24–FY25 CoC NOFO.
- HUD clarified:
 - CoCs renewing FY24 awards do not need to submit additional materials
 - Additional submissions are required only in limited circumstances
- **None** of the circumstances apply to WA-500.
 - Therefore:
 - No project applications are required
 - No Priority Listing is required
 - HUD only required formal written notification from the Collaborative Applicant



HUD Informed

- CEO Kinnison informed HUD of KCRHA's intent to renew all 52 grants and the CoC Planning Grant on January 30.
- No other information or materials are required.



What's to Come

- THUD Appropriations passed and signed with both FY25 & FY26 funding.
 - FY25 Grant agreements should start being processed soon.
 - FY26: A floor for Annual Renewal Demand (ARD) set by Congress to be no less than 60%.
 - FY26 NOFO must be released by June 2026 and have awards by December 2026
