2026 Encampment Resolution Permanent Supportive Housing Underspend RFP March 16, 2026

The King County Regional Homelessness Authority (KCRHA) is pleased to announce a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the 2026 Encampment Resolution Permanent Supportive Housing Underspend Request for Proposals (RFP). KCRHA expects to open an RFP to fund currently contracted organizations to provide expanded Encampment Resolution Program (ERP) Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) services. Identified underspend funds are anticipated to be available in an upcoming RFP, and awarded applicants will go through a subsequent contract amendment process.

The RFP is intended to ensure all ERP funds are fully expended and utilized efficiently with high standards of integrity to ensure quality-of-service delivery for people utilizing PSH services. KCRHA expects to award funds for organizations that:

- Are currently contracted ERP PSH providers and property managers in King County
- Provide high-quality scattered and site-based PSH case management and services
- Provide comprehensive population-specific services that are person-centered
- Meet data and reporting requirements

Due to fund source limitations, only agencies that currently receive ERP funding to provide services in King County are eligible to apply, which includes:
