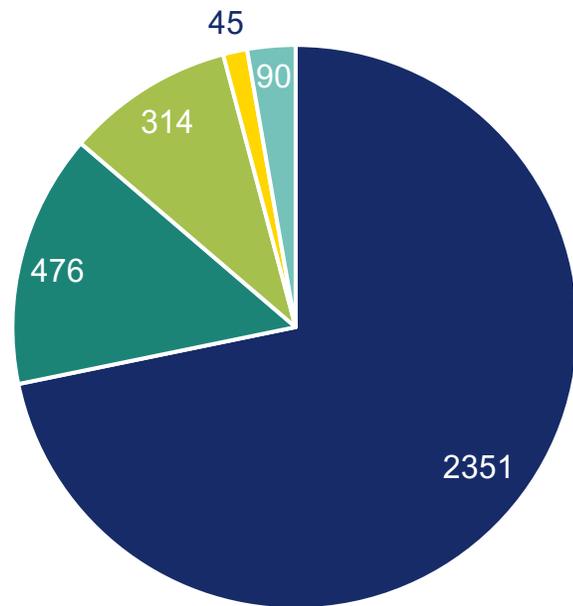

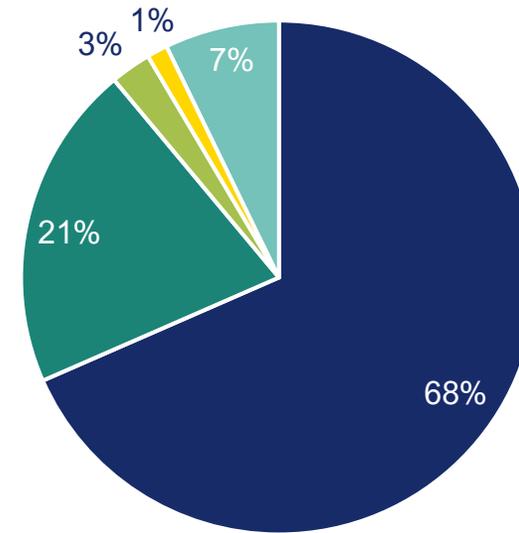
CoC Portfolio - FY24 Funding Overview

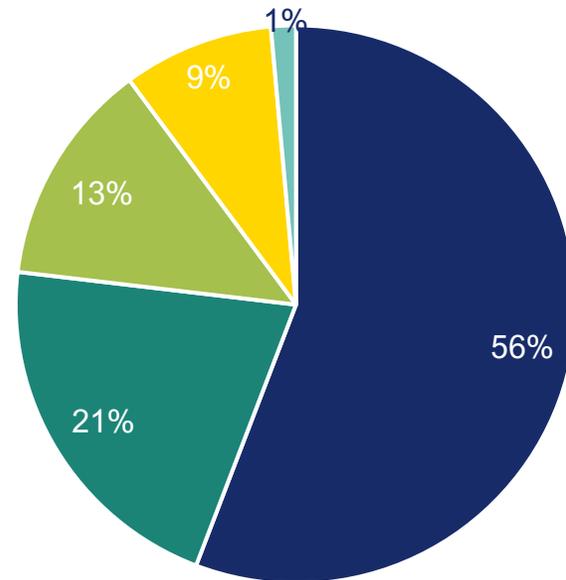
